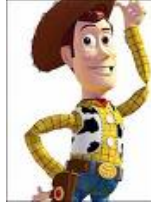


Respecting Toys



Howdy there pardner, it's me Woody. I'm here to talk to you about respecting your toys, and your friends' toys too.

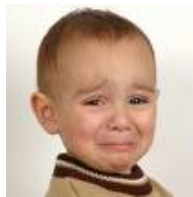


To respect something means to take care of it. That means you don't throw it, step on it, break it, or kick it.
